If you already have such a test certificate, please send it now with your application. If not, and you are offered a place on our course, <u>you will be required to provide a test certificate proving you have level</u> <u>B1 in English before you come</u>.

- You're able to pay for your return or onward journey (or have funding from someone else).
- You'll leave the UK at the end of your studies.

10. Documents to include with your application form

- ✓ Photocopy or scan of the document you have showing that your level of competence in the English language is B1 if English is not your first language.
- If you do not have any of those documents, submit your application without them and give a note of explanation.
- If any document is in a language other than English, please include a translation. (This does not have to be an official translation; you can translate it yourself)
- Remember you will need to take out comprehensive HEALTH INSURANCE before you travel.

Self-Declaration Form Information

As a potential student at the International Bible Training College, after receiving your application we need you to complete a **Self-Declaration Form** before we can proceed with your application. You will receive an email from our Safeguarding Coordinator (<u>safeguarding@ibti.org.uk</u>) with a Self-Declaration Form that you need to complete and return. This form will provide information of any conviction of a criminal offence, caution, reprimand or warning. This will not necessarily result in you not being accepted as a student but may affect some of the activities you can be involved in. CODE OF CONDUCT

- The IBTI requires the highest standard of behavior between students and staff, and Christian submission to those in authority.
